Kukkuu hat



General Information

Kukkuu hat is a trendy beginner-friendly project. This hat knits up fast, and it's an absolute must for the colder weather.



Materials

200 g Katia Love Wool, 50 m / 100 g | 15% Superfine Alpaca 85% Virgin Wool

Circular needles 8.00 mm/US 4, 80 cm/32" or 40 cm/16" (or DPNs, if you prefer)

Gauge

10 sts x 14 rnds = $10 \text{ cm} \times 10 \text{ cm}/4 \times 4^{\circ}$ over 1x1 rib in the round with 8 mm/US 6 needles

Size

1 & 2

Circumference size $1 = 48 \text{ cm}/19^{\circ}$, size $2 = 52 \text{ cm}/20.5^{\circ}$

Length 32 cm/12.6" both sizes.

Pattern

With your preferred method, cast on 48 (52) stitches. <u>Tubular cast on</u> is used in the original hat.

Once you've joined to knit in the round, place a marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Knit 1, purl 1 for 30 cm.

Decrease round 1: Move the 1st stitch without knitting it to be the last stitch, from the left needle to the right needle. K2tog the entire round. 24 (26) stitches left.

Knit 1 round (knit all stitches).

Decrease round 2: K2tog the entire round. 12 (13) stitches left. Break yarn. Sew yarn ends to the wrong side.

Steam or wool wash hat, block to measurements. Wear and enjoy!

Cm centimeter

DPN double pointed needles

K2tog knit 2 stitches together



Rnds rounds

Sts stitches
