BROOKLYN



A warm and soft organic wool jacket made in a Ribbed Stitch. An open model inspired by the world of fairy tales, made more precious and particular by a wide and worked sleeve.



Yarn: ECHOS col. 46 grey.

Needles: n. 7 and 7,5


Weight: 970 g/ 34,21 oz. (20 balls).

Tg. 42 - S

Stitches Used: 2x2 Rib, 1x1 Rib, Chained Rib*, Garter Stitch, Stockinette Stitch, Reversed Stockinette Stitch.

Gauge: 10 cm x 10 cm (4 inc. x 4 inc.): 12 stitches and 17 rows.

Size S: For each bigger or smaller size calculate in width 2 cm (0,75 in.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 2 stitches; calculate in height 2 cm (0,75 in.) more or less, in our gauge it corresponds to 4 rows.





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Knitting the Back: With needles n. 7 and col. grey, cast on 70 stitches and work in **2x2 Rib**. At a total height of 30 cm (11,81 in.), for the armhole, decrease 2 stitches at sides. At a total height of 50 cm (19,68 in.), for the shoulders, bind off at sides 8 stitches twice, 4 stitches once. Bind off the 26 remaining stitches.

Knitting the Left Front: With needles n. 7 and col. grey, cast on 40 stitches and work in **2x2 Rib**, starting with purl 1, and finishing working 4 stitches in **Garter Stitch**. At a total height of 30 cm (11,81 in.), for the armhole, decrease the first 2 stitches. Continue in **2x2 Rib** and the same 4 stitches in **Garter Stitch**. At a total height of 44 cm (17,32 in.), for the neckline, bind off the last 10 stitches, then continue decreasing 2 stitches every 2 rows once, 1 stitch every 2 rows 4 times. At a total height of 50 cm (19,68 in.), for the shoulder, bind off 8 stitches twice, 4 stitches once. Bind off the 6 remaining stitches.

Knitting the Right Front: Work as for the left front but in inverse direction. In the right front, we will make the buttonholes. The first is done in the **Garter Stitch's** edge, at a total height of 5 cm (1,97 in.). Then the others every 10 cm (3,94 in.), we will have a total of 4 buttonholes. To make a buttonhole, work 1 psso and 1 yo inside the first stitch, then work them normally on the next row.

Sleeves: With needles n. 7 and col. grey, cast on 72 stitches and work in **2x2 Rib** for 2 rows, then work as follow: 24 stitches in **Stockinette Stitch**, 4 stitches in **Reversed Stockinette Stitch**, 16 stitches in **Chained Rib**, 4 stitches in **Reversed Stockinette Stitch**, 24 stitches in **Stockinette Stitch**. Continue decreasing 4 stitches in total (1 stitch at the beginning of the needle, 1 stitch at the end, 2 stitches before and after the **Chained Rib** part) on the 7th row of **Chained Rib**, for 6 times. Continue with the 48 remaining stitches up to 55 cm (21,65 in.) of total height. Then bind off all stitches. Make other sleeve as the first one.





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Neck Warmer: With needles n. 7,5 and col. grey, cast on 84 stitches and work in **2x2 Rib** for 2 rows, then work as follow: 30 stitches in **Stockinette Stitch**, 4 stitches in **Reversed Stockinette Stitch**, 16 stitches in **Chained Rib**, 4 stitches in **Reversed Stockinette Stitch**. At a total height of 32 cm (12,59 in.), bind off all stitches.

Finishing: Sew shoulders, sides, underarms and apply the sleeves. Sew the buttons.

Explanation Chained Rib:

Work over a multiple of 16 stitches.

1st - 3rd - 5th - 7th row: knit1, (purl2, knit2) repeat twice the part in brackets, purl2, knit1.

2nd row and all even rows: work stitches as they are.

9th row: Slip 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in back, knit1, purl2, knit1 working as follow the slipped stitches: knit1, purl2, knit1. Slip 4 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front, knit1, purl2, knit1 working as follow the slipped stitches: knit1, purl2, knit1.

11th row: repeat from the 1st row.
