Hallanvaara



This generous but light cowl is knitted out of a combination of wool and silk mohair. It's perfect to be worn outside on top of your coat, but keeps you equally warm indoors as well as it sits beautifully on top of any outfit. Little pom poms on both sides of the slit add the final touch to the cowl, but you can also choose to leave those out.

Materials

Yarn: Tukuwool Fingering (200 m / 50 g),
colourway Sake, 150 g total

Isager Silk Mohair (212 m / 25 g), colourway
06, 75 g total

Needles: 4.5 mm / 60 or 80 cm long circular
needles

Gauge: 15 sts x 32 rows / knitted in chart A

Finished measurements: circumference at the
beginning 80 cm, after all increases 180 cm,
total length 45 cm

Directions

Border

Using a strand of each yarn and the shorter
needles, cast on 120 sts and join to work in
the round.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: Purl.

Repeat rows 1–2 two more times.

Body of the cowl

Start following chart A.

Repeat chart A for a total of 8 times (48 rnds

in total).

Then repeat chart B once and then rows 9–16
once more.

Next repeat chart C once.

Repeat chart D once.

Repeat chart E once.

Change to the longer needles when needed.

Border

*Note! This time the garter stitch border is knitted
flat.*

(K8, m1r, k3, m1l, k5), repeat 14 more times.

270 sts. Turn work and knit one row. Work

14 rows of garter stitch in total. Bind off

loosely. Break the yarn and weave in the yarn
ends to the wrong side of the work. Wash the
cowl gently by hand using wool wash. Gently
squeeze any excess water out and then place
the cowl on a towel. Roll in to remove any
moisture. Lay flat to dry. Make two small pom
poms and sew them on both sides of the slit.

Read charts from bottom to top and from
right to left.

With left needle, lift strand between needles from front to back and knit the lifted loop through the back.

m1lp
make 1 left purlwise
With left needle, lift strand between needles from front to back and purl the lifted loop through the back.
