Tunturi hat



General information

A cozy and simple hat that knits up in one night using thick woolen yarn and silk-mohair.



Materials

 $100~{\rm g}$ Fritidsgarn + 25 g Tynn Silk Mohair

6 mm/80 cm or 40 cm circulars or DPN's if you prefer

Gauge

14 sts x 20 rounds = $10 \text{ cm} \times 10 \text{ cm}/4 \times 4$ " in False English ribbing in the round on 6 mm needles

One size

Circumference approx. 48,5 cm

Pattern

Cast on 68 sts with <u>Tubular cast on</u> method or your preferred cast on method.

Start moss rib pattern:

Round 1: k 3, $p1^*$, repeat till the end of the round.

Round 2: p1, k1, p 2*, *repeat till the end of the round

Repeat rounds 1 & 2 until work measures approximately 30 cm.

Decrease round 1: CDD, 1 p * repeat until the end of the round. 34 sts.

Knit 1 round as follows: k 1, p1 until the end of the round.

Decrease round 2: K2tog until the end of the round. 17 sts.

Break yarn. Pull it through the remaining live stitches. Weave in yarn ends to the wrong side.

Wetblock or steam block, let it dry. Wear and enjoy!

Abbreviations

CDD centered double decrease, lift 2 stitches as if to work a k2tog. Knit 1 stitch, pass both slipped stitches over the knit stitch.

DPN double pointed needles

K knit





K2tog knit 2 stitches together

P purl

Sts stitches
